Mr. Richter requested compensation for those seven days whether snow is forecasted or not. Mr. Richter emphasized the importance of snow watch citing that the Snow and Ice Plan dictates a maximum snow depth of 1-2" of snow. A motion was made by Mr. Lorenson and supported by Mr. Snyder to authorize snow watch as outlined for seven days per week on a trial period.
